

## QASMT School Fees 2026

At the Queensland Academy for Science Mathematics and Technology (QASMT), we offer an exceptional educational environment and provide extensive opportunities for all students. The education at QASMT is provided through an international curriculum, the International Baccalaureate (IB), and focusses on a holistic education. Our environment is STEM and enrichment focussed, providing opportunities beyond the standard normally experienced at a secondary school.

The school fee structure at QASMT is comprised of three categories, IB Programme fees, Student Resource Scheme (SRS) and User Pays. School fees are invoiced to QASMT families at the start of the school year to support the delivery of education for students. Payment of the IB, SRS and User Pays are essential to the operation of the school.

An overview of fees and associated information is provided below, and a detailed schedule of fees is included.

### International Baccalaureate Fees

Fees for the IB curriculum, offered through the Queensland Academies, are used to facilitate the costs associated with the IB Organisation charges and conditions. These fees are mandatory and must be paid by the due date for ongoing enrolment in the IB programmes.

### Student Resource Scheme Fees

The [Student Resource Scheme \(SRS\)](#) is a user-charging scheme operated by schools to provide parents access to individual student resources not funded by the government. Each school develops their own SRS based on specific resources needed by their students and the programs they offer. At QASMT the SRS includes the school yearbook, student year level diary, printed reference material and consumables including general laboratory, design and art materials.

### User Pay Fees

User pay fees are charges for certain resources in services, that aren't included in the SRS. At QASMT these include educational services provided through an external provider (e.g. wellbeing programs, VET), camps, commercial activities (school refectory), whole of year level excursions, affiliation fees and more. A full breakdown of these fees charged for each year level can be found in the school fee schedule.

### Optional Fees

QASMT offers a number of optional activities (e.g. sports, robotics, debating, learning success), excursions, year level celebrations, study tours, and more, to enhance the educational experience for each of our students. Costs of these activities will be communicated to parents and carers at the time of sign up, and fees must be paid prior to your student participating in these programs.

Charges for these activities are based on a cost recovery basis and are determined by expenses incurred for the activity and the number of participants. Parents and carers are informed of these fees prior to students participating in the activity to allow them to make an informed decision. As these activities are optional, students will not be permitted to participate if payment is not received by the required due date.



## Textbook and Resource Allowance

QASMT does not operate a textbook hire scheme. Parents and carers are directed to purchase textbooks and stationery resources required at their discretion. A textbook and stationery list is available for each year level through the [Campion Education website](#) or via the QASMT enrolments team. Whilst the lists are published through this site, parents and carers are welcome to purchase these materials through a provider of their choice.

The Queensland Government provides a Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) to parents and caregivers of eligible students to offset the costs of textbook and resources purchased. The allowance is paid directly to the school, and the school then credits the allowance to its eligible families on behalf of the Department of Education. The TRA varies annually and is set by the Department of Education.

The TRA for 2026 is:

- \$164.00 for Year 7-10 students
- \$357.00 for Year 11-12 students

Most students are eligible to receive the TRA once per year for six years (or for the duration of their enrolment at QASMT). Students are not eligible if they are enrolled as a full fee-paying international student or temporary visa holder or are enrolled after the first Friday in August. Parents and carers will have the value of the TRA credited on their academy fees invoice through the User Pay Fees.

## Invoices

Academy fees are invoiced and emailed to parents and caregivers in January each year. Fees can be paid for the whole year or over three instalments. The full payment of fees is required by 28 July 2026.

Academy fees due dates:

- A. Full amount paid by 28 July 2026; OR
- B. Three instalments due:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> instalment – 28 February 2026
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment – 28 April 2026
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> instalment – 28 July 2026

## Payment Options

The following payment options are available at QASMT:

- School Fees: QParents, BPOINT (phone and internet), BPAY, QParents, Qkr!, bank deposit, Centrepay, or in person at the Student Services counter, A Block.
- Optional Fees: Qkr!, bank deposit, or in person at Student Services counter, A Block.

Please note QASMT is unable to take payments over the phone.

If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact our Business Manager (Corporate Services) in Term 1 to set up a Payment Plan. A Payment Plan allows you to pay fees gradually and we will work with families to develop a mutually suitable plan. By contacting us early, you can ensure your child's optional activities are managed responsibly.



## Non-payment of fees

IB and User Pay Fees apply to all QASMT students. It is essential that fees are paid by their due date so that resources can be provided to maintain the standard of education delivered. QASMT ensures that all school activities are resourced well, and to a high standard, and this cannot happen without your support.

Non-payment of fees may result in debt recovery action in accordance with the [Department's Debt Management procedure](#), and the QASMT debt collection process. In such cases, the Principal may withdraw the student's participation in the user pays scheme or withhold the provision of items identified, and exclude the student from optional, non-curricular activities and/or initiate debt recovery action.
