# ALUMNI

QASMT IB graduates are highly focused, balanced and internationally-minded citizens of the world. During their time at QASMT, the students in our care, mature into enthusiastic and empathetic lifelong learners, inspired with the confidence of budding global leaders and change makers.

Our Academy intentionally blurs the line between secondary school and university, thus our graduates transition from QASMT specifically well equipped for study at university level. 88% of QASMT Year 12 graduates (2018) were studying a Bachelor's Degree in 2019 (compared to 40% of all Year 12 completers in Queensland) (Department of Education's Next Step Post-School Destinations Survey). Over 70% of QASMT graduates study a STEM-related field at university.

Our partnerships with The University of Queensland (4.6 kms from the QASMT campus), Queensland University of Technology (7.4 kms) and Griffith University (14.5 kms), ensure students have access to

technology and exposure to cutting-edge disciplines in a manner that values academic precision.

In addition to studying at Australia's top universities, a number of QASMT IB Diploma recipients choose to continue their learning journey abroad, at internationally acclaimed institutions, such as Cambridge and Oxford in the UK, Austin Health in the USA and the National University of Singapore.

Reflecting the esteem with which our Academy holds our Alumni, we invite the top performers back on to campus after graduation, as part of our innovative Learning Enhancement Program to extend QASMT students. The Program employs past students as tutors to support the learning and university goals of current students. In collaboration with our inspirational teachers, the continuance of academic and personal achievement at the highest level is assured.
