



Life at QASMT is not all about studying. To round out the rich educational experience offered at QASMT, EOTC are curriculum based learning experiences that go beyond the walls of the classroom, such as camps, international tours and opportunities in music, sport and STEM (see a selection of STEM CCA's below at quicklinks). Powerful aspects of a student's identity, such as the development of social skills, problem solving and self-reliance, are core components of these experiences.

QASMT's camp and conference program targets the specific needs of each year level and prepares and supports students for particular points in time in their Academy journey.

#### Our current camp/retreat program:

- **Year 7 Relationship Building Camp** - Working collaboratively to take risks and achieve goals;
- **Year 8 Altruistic Service to Others Project** - How positive purpose makes you feel;
- **Year 9 Reflecting on The MYP Journey and Preparing Ahead Camp** – Setting goals and taking on challenges;
- **Year 10 Diploma Preparation Program** - Positive health, looking after ourselves, and positive engagement committing to positive social behaviours;
- **Year 11 Leadership Program** - Positive purpose, team building, leadership and independence;
- **Year 12 Mindset Development Conference** - Positive accomplishment through challenge.

There are many other regular co-curricular activities offered (as part of the Co-curricular Activities Program), enabling students to explore their passions and extend their horizons. From Robotics, Debating, Dungeons & Dragons, Chess, Knitting, Creative Writing and more.

Optional enrichment opportunities include:

- **Academy Ensemble-based Music Program** - QASMT offers every MYP student a 35-minute small group instrumental music lesson per week. DP students involved in ensembles receive support through sectionals and ensemble rehearsals. We currently offer 13 ensembles (Choir, Wind Orchestra, Big Band, String and Percussion ensembles) ensuring students of all musical aptitude can advance their musicianship.
- **Academy Sport Program** - caters for a variety of abilities, experience and levels of competition, such as inter-House, inter-school (including district and regional programs), and a professional coaching program. Within the school, inter-House competitions include the Athletics Carnival and Cross Country. Students at these events also participate in a range of fun and inclusive House challenges which strengthen House ties and a positive school culture.
- **Special Tours/Conferences** – Educational, immersive and cultural STEM Tours to Europe and Japan to grow students' international mindedness; Annual CAS Activity Ski Tour pushes students to new limits in a supportive and fun environment; International Student Science Fair (ISSF) for specialist science high schools around the world; SuperComputing International Conference for High Performance Computing, Networking, Storage and Analysis.
- **The Bridge Award** - for Year 7 to 8. The Bridge Award is a positive, fun and challenging youth development program laying the foundation for the Duke of Edinburgh International Award.
