



QASMT's strict adherence to school uniform standards boosts school spirit and sense of belonging, and instills positive values among the students. Pride in uniform at QASMT eliminates distractions and our philosophy regarding the neat and professional presentation of our students is fully supported by our P&C and Education Queensland. To this end, policies surrounding hairstyles, jewellery and makeup are also firmly upheld to create an environment strongly focused on learning.

QASMT students wear the school uniform with pride, and uniform standards are maintained at all times, inside and outside the school grounds. Discernible by their striking red blazers, Junior students (Year 7-9) wear a different uniform to their peers in Years 10-12.

Students wear a day uniform, formal uniform and an active wear uniform. The day uniform

is worn in Terms 1 and 4, while the formal uniform is worn in Terms 2 and 3, on excursions and formal occasions and events. Students are not permitted to wear the active wear uniform travelling to or from school.

A QASMT-branded white laboratory coat and goggles are requisite attire for learning in science laboratories all year round.

The school cap is compulsory with the active wear uniform, and students are encouraged to apply sunscreen (as per Department of Education and Training's Sun Safety in Secondary Schools Guidelines). Students in Year 7-11 must wear a broad brimmed school hat with their day and formal uniform.
