WORK PROFILE

Queensland Academy for Science, Mathematics and Technology is a selective entry school, located within four kilometres of Brisbane City centre.

The Academy opened in January 2007 and works in partnership with a range of universities, including the University of Queensland, in nurturing highly capable students in achieving their potential as future leaders in a science specialist school environment.

QASMT is an International Baccalaureate World School and is proud to uphold the values of an IB education. In the coming years QASMT will be expanding its cohort from its current Year 10-12 program to a Year 7-12 program. As a science specialist school, the study of STEM will be integral across Years 7 – 12. QASMT currently offers the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IBD) as its core curriculum in years 11 and 12. The IBD is a demanding pre-university course of study that leads to external examinations. It has earned a reputation for rigorous learning and assessment, and as such gives IBD holders access to the world's leading universities. The program incorporates the strengths of a traditional curriculum, but with three important additional features, Creativity Action and Service, Theory of Knowledge and Extended Essay.

The Head of Department STEM and Enrichment portfolio includes the leadership and management of effective teaching and learning across curriculum the curriculum areas of STEM, including Physics, Computer Science, Digital Technologies/Design, Coding and Robotics. This role will also manage the IT activities across the school to ensure QASMT offers a technology-rich learning environment. Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- leading curriculum and enrichment activities in developing, articulating and committing to a shared educational vision focussed on providing quality learning outcomes for all students within the DET strategic vision and IB framework for our students in STEM;
- leading the vision for technology based learning;
- setting high standards for student and staff performance;
- managing the human, financial, facilities and curriculum resources to achieve goals and targets.

The Head of Department will focus on developing STEM opportunities by leading a team of teachers in the development of specific curriculum and pedagogical approaches suitable for motivating and engaging highly capable students as we expand our curriculum offerings across Years 7 – 12. The expansion of our STEM offerings, including the development of an innovative makerspace will be a key priority of this role. Under the supervision of the Deputy Principal, the STEM and Enrichment HoD is responsible for recruitment and selection of staff, curriculum development, tracking and monitoring of students, parent liaison and staff development and supervision. The HoD STEM and Enrichment works closely with the HoD Science, faculty and staff across the QA brand to promote STEM education in our context as a science specialist school and as a member of the International Science Schools Network.

QASMT is committed to establishing, maintaining and strengthening partnerships across sectors, universities and industry, and the Head of Department STEM and Enrichment is expected to develop a range of programs for mutual advantage for both our campus students and our outreach students. This position will also work closely with QASMT's outreach programs, the Queensland Virtual STEM Academy and Students Performing Advanced Research Queensland (SPARQed).
